2. Objects of the Association

The Objects of the Association shall be:

- 2.1 To oppose the Walker Corporation's 2004 development proposal for Ralphs Bay at Lauderdale, and any subsequent development proposals for Ralphs Bay deemed by SRB to be inappropriate;
- 2.2 To work towards the future protection of the natural and aesthetic values of Ralphs Bay such that further proposals of this nature cannot be put forward;
- 2.3 To promote an approach to Coastal Planning in Tasmania that will prevent future inappropriate development proposals in coastal areas;
- 2.4 To bring into closer understanding and co-operation the supporters of SRB for the purposes set out above, and to convene, organise and co-ordinate such meetings, activities and events (including fundraising) as may be deemed necessary.

3. Membership

- 3.1 Any person who supports the Objects of the Association shall become a Member of the Association on completion of the Membership Form and payment of the Membership Fee.
- 3.2 Supporters (whose names have been collected at SRB meetings and on stalls promoting SRB) shall be invited to become Members by completion of the Membership Form and return of this to the Treasurer.
- 3.3 Any person whose activities are deemed by the SRB Coordinating Committee to be in opposition to the Objects of Association set out above shall not be a member of SRB.
