While we had a number of concerns about the Ralph's Bay development, the proper place for those to be considered is through the approval process. We support proper process being followed by both the developer and opponents to the development to be heard before the Tasmanian Planning Commission.

Before Parliament was prorogued, on 18 November, the Liberals moved that the whole matter of canal development be referred to the Joint Standing Committee on Environment, Resources and Development, and we will revive that reference when then new Parliament convenes.

We believe the Tasmanian Planning Commission must receive adequate resources from government to perform its function
